

## Instructions for FeedCaster Kit

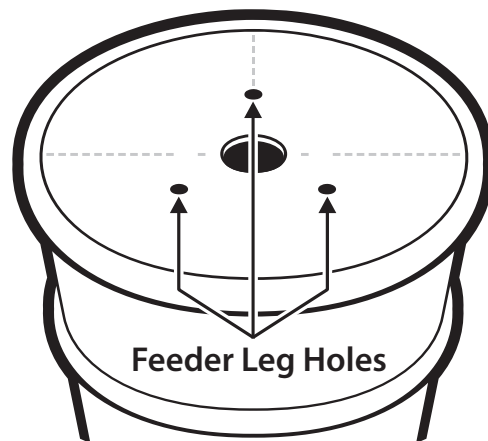
### I DRILLING YOUR BARREL OR BUCKET

**NOTE:** If you purchased a Moultrie barrel, go to step II

*FeedCaster will mount to the bottom of any barrel or bucket*

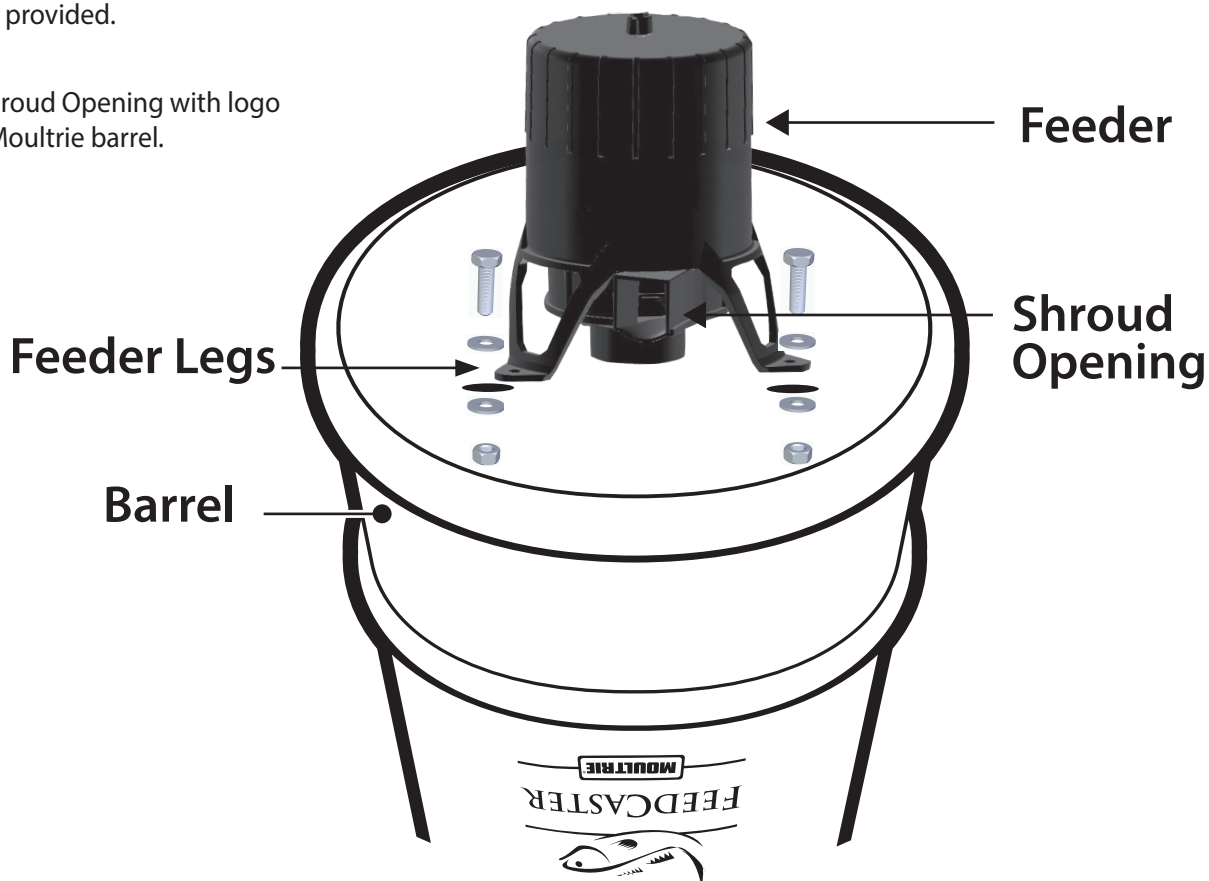
**CAUTION: WEAR EYE PROTECTION**

- 1 Turn barrel over, measure and mark the center of the bottom.
- 2 Center the provided template on the bottom of the barrel and secure with tape. Drill three 5/16" Feeder Leg Holes.
- 3 Using a Hole Saw, drill a 2.25" hole in the center of the bottom of your barrel.



### II MOUNTING THE FEEDER

- 1 Turn Barrel upside down.
- 2 Place Feeder on Barrel. Attach Feeder Legs to Barrel as shown with Bolts using nuts and washers provided.
- 3 Align Shroud Opening with logo on the Moultrie barrel.

## III INSTALLING BATTERY

**CAUTION: WEAR EYE PROTECTION**

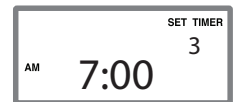
Remove bottom and install a 6-Volt Alkaline (ex. Energizer™) or Moultrie rechargeable 6-Volt battery. Connect the Red Alligator Clip to the positive terminal (+) and the Black Alligator Clip to the negative (-) terminal.



## IV CONFIGURING AND TESTING FEEDER

Your FeedCaster Kit will feed up to six times per day and has been factory set to feed at 7:00am and 6:00pm for four seconds. To change the factory settings or add additional feed times, follow the instructions below. The Battery Level is displayed every seven seconds. It is recommended that the battery be replaced when the %BATTERY reading is 25% or below.

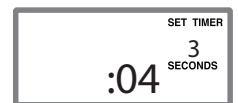
**1 SET TIME OF DAY:** Press the UP or DOWN button until the correct time of day appears. Press and release button to single-step through the minutes or hold down to advance quickly.



**2 SET FEED TIMES:** Press the SET button until the correct Timer Number appears in the upper right hand corner as shown. Press the UP or DOWN button to set the Feed Time. **Note: Factory settings are 7am and 6pm.**



**3 SET RUN DURATION:** Press the SET button again to set the RUN-TIME SECONDS which can range from zero to twenty seconds. Adjust RUN-TIME SECONDS using the chart below. Set the RUN-TIME SECONDS to zero to disable the specific timer. **Note: Factory setting is 6 seconds.**

**4 TEST FEEDER:** PRESS AND HOLD the SET button while the RUN-TIME SECONDS are displayed. Release the button and get away from the feeder when the message "TESTING GET AWAY" appears on the display.

### Helpful Tips:

- For best results, Moultrie recommends use of .250" floating pellets.
- For extended battery life, the Moultrie Deluxe Solar Panel (MFH-DSP) or Feeder PowerPanel (MFA-12602) can be added using the External Power Port.
- For added security against pests, the Moultrie Varmint Guard (MFH-VG) can be added.
- Replacement parts can be purchased from Moultrie's customer service line at the number below.
